

LAUDERHILL ROUTES 6 & 7 COMMUNITY SHUTTLES

The City of Lauderhill and Broward County Transit (BCT) have partnered to provide the Lauderhill 6 and 7 routes. This free service will increase the number of destinations and connections that can be reached through public transit. Destinations along the Lauderhill 6 and 7 Routes include: Lauderhill Transit Center, Plantation Hospital, Thunderbird Swap Shop, Lauderhill Central Park Library, Saint George Park and the surrounding neighborhoods.

Connections are available to BCT routes 9, 18, 19, 36, 40, 81, US 441 Breeze, and the Lauderdale Lakes North/South, and Lauderhill 1 and 5 Community Shuttle routes.

All shuttles on this route are air-conditioned and wheelchair accessible in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Bicycle racks are also provided. Please refer to this pamphlet for instructions on how to correctly use the bicycle racks.

Lauderhill 6 and 7 routes are free of charge. However riders making connections to BCT routes and other Community Shuttle routes that charge fares are expected to pay the appropriate fares.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Monday through Friday: 7 am – 11am: 3 pm – 7 pm

Lauderhill Routes 6 and 7 operate approximately every 30 to 40 minutes with assigned stops. Please refer to the timetable and map on the reverse side of this pamphlet. The shuttle will operate as close to schedule as possible. Traffic conditions and/or inclement weather may cause the bus to arrive earlier or later than the expected time. Please allow yourself enough time when using this service.

Lauderhill routes 6 and 7 will not operate once a hurricane warning has been issued or if other hazards do not allow the safe operation of the shuttle.

HOLIDAYS

Lauderhill Routes 6 and 7 do not operate on the following holidays observed by City of Lauderhill:

New Year's Day
Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Day

BIKE RACKS

Bike racks are available on Lauderhill 6 and 7 Routes. Bike racks are designed to carry two bikes only. It is important to have the operator's attention before loading and unloading your bike. As the bus approaches, have your bike ready to load. Remove any loose items that may fall off.

LOADING

- Always load your bike from the curbside of the street.
- Lower-Squeeze the handle and pull down to release the folded bike rack.
- Lift your bike into the rack, fitting the wheels into the slots of the vacant position closest to the bus.
- Latch-Pull and release the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the fender or frame.

UNLOADING

- Before exiting, notify the operator you are removing your bike.
 - Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way.
- Lift your bike out of the rack. If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position.

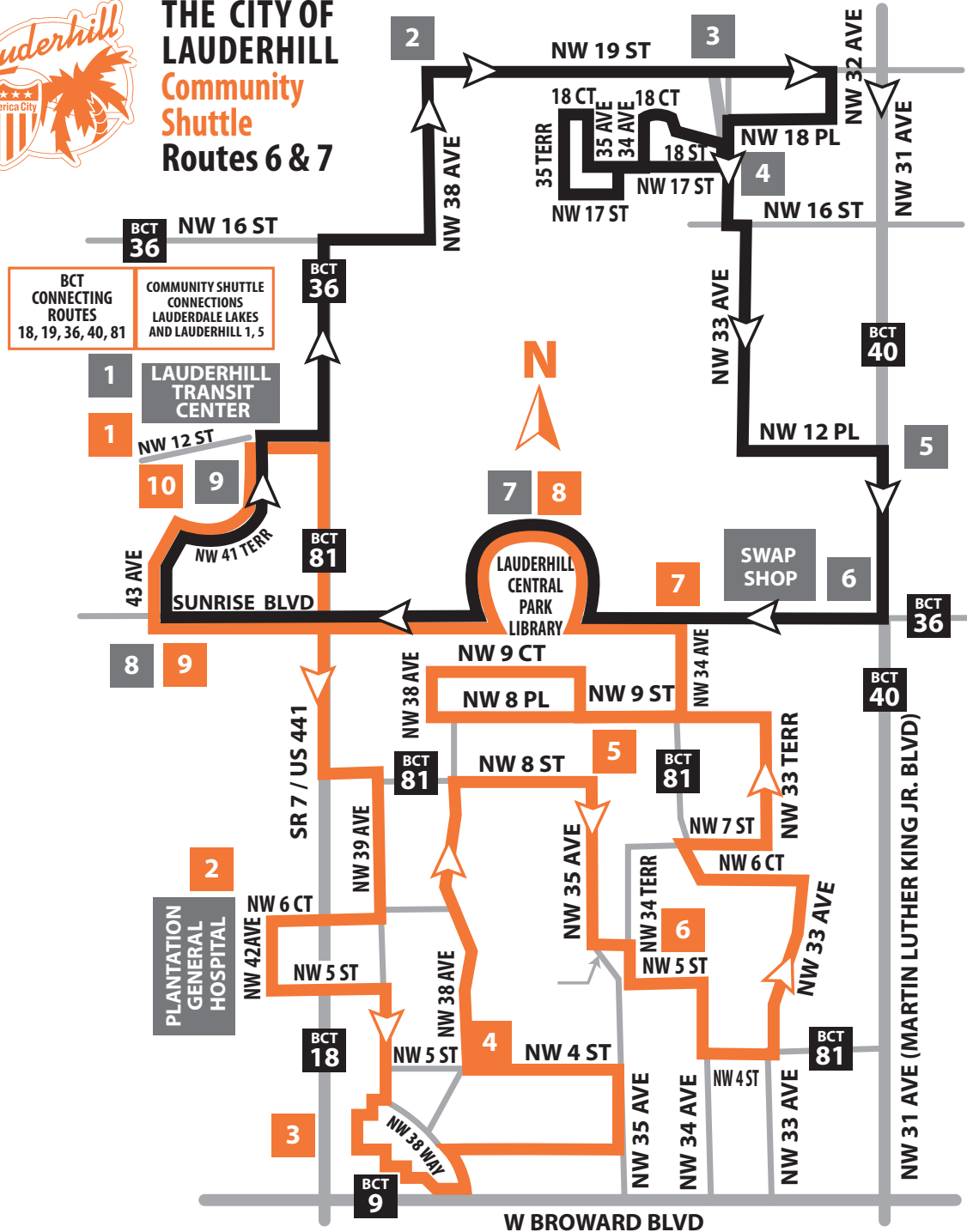
