



CITY OF LAUDERHILL RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR CANDIDATES

In order to qualify to become a candidate for mayor or for city commissioner, you must provide proof of residency to the city clerk that you have been a permanent resident of the City of Lauderhill for a continuous twenty-four (24) month period prior to the date of the next scheduled election.

Please provide the following forms of identification.

- A valid U.S. Government issued driver's license or ID card containing individuals name and valid Lauderhill address
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In addition to the above requirement, please provide (1) of the following:

- A lease, rental receipt, deed, mortgage statement, homeowners or renters insurance policy that contains name and a valid Lauderhill residential address
- A property tax bill that contains name and a valid Lauderhill residential address
- A utility bill that contains the individual's name and a valid Lauderhill residential address
- A voter registration card showing name and a valid Lauderhill residential address

All documents shall have an issue date **on or before** the first of the November, two (2) years before the election candidate files to run for office.
