A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL APPROVING WEEKLY EXTENSIONS OF THE DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL REGARDING COVID-19 PROSPECTIVELY ON A WEEKLY BASIS TO BE DEEMED EFFECTIVE EACH WEEK THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2021 WHILE THE CITY COMMISSION IS ON RECESS FOR SUMMER BREAK; PROVIDING THAT EACH WEEKLY EXTENSION SHALL ONLY BE VALID AND TAKE EFFECT SO LONG AS THE STATE OF FLORIDA REMAINS UNDER A DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY REGARDING COVID-19; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (REQUESTED BY CITY MANAGER DESORAE GILES-SMITH)

WHEREAS, the State of Florida remains under a State of Emergency regarding COVOD-19 which was initially declared on March 9, 2020 at 5:52 p.m., Governor Ron DeSantis via Executive Order Number 20-52 activating the Florida Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and declaring that a State of Emergency exists in the State of Florida, which has been extended thereafter and which remains in effect; and

WHEREAS, Broward County and the City of Lauderhill also continue to remain under a declared State of Emergency, which have been extended on a weekly basis and which remain in effect; and

WHEREAS, SB 2006 requires the majority vote of the governing body to extend the weekly declaration of a State of Emergency within the City of Lauderhill; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission for the City of Lauderhill will be on recess for summer break commencing July 14, 2021 through August 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution prospectively approves the continued weekly extensions of the Declaration of a State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 within the City of Lauderhill, as deemed necessary by the City Manager, during the summer recess until the City Commission meetings resume on August 30, 2021; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the weekly extension of the declaration of the State of Emergency that exists in the City of Lauderhill regarding COVID-19 is hereby approved to be extended for the seventy-first (71st) seven (7) day extension effective July 20, 2021 through July 27, 2021, unless otherwise terminated or extended, if deemed necessary by the City Manager, so long as the State of Florida remains under a declared State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 at that time.

SECTION 2. That the weekly extension of the declaration of the State of Emergency that exists in the City of Lauderhill regarding COVID-19 is hereby approved to be extended for the seventy-second (72nd) seven (7) day extension effective July 27, 2021 through August 3, 2021, unless otherwise terminated or extended, if deemed

necessary by the City Manager, so long as the State of Florida remains under a declared State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 at that time.

SECTION 3. That the weekly extension of the declaration of the State of Emergency that exists in the City of Lauderhill regarding COVID-19 is hereby approved to be extended for the seventy-third (73rd) seven (7) day extension effective August 3, 2021 through August 10, 2021, unless otherwise terminated or extended, if deemed necessary by the City Manager, so long as the State of Florida remains under a declared State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 at that time.

SECTION 4. That the weekly extension of the declaration of the State of Emergency that exists in the City of Lauderhill regarding COVID-19 is hereby approved to be extended for the seventy-fourth (74th) seven (7) day extension effective August 10, 2021 through August 17, 2021, unless otherwise terminated or extended, if deemed necessary by the City Manager, so long as the State of Florida remains under a declared State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 at that time.

SECTION 5. That the weekly extension of the declaration of the State of Emergency that exists in the City of Lauderhill regarding COVID-19 is hereby approved to be extended for the seventy-fifth (75th) seven (7) day extension effective August 17, 2021 through August 24, 2021, unless otherwise terminated or extended, if deemed necessary by the City Manager, so long as the State of Florida remains under a declared State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 at that time.

SECTION 6. That the weekly extension of the declaration of the State of Emergency that exists in the City of Lauderhill regarding COVID-19 is hereby approved to be extended for the seventy-sixth (76th) seven (7) day extension effective August 24, 2021 through August 31, 2021, unless otherwise terminated or extended, if deemed necessary by the City Manager, so long as the State of Florida remains under a declared State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 at that time.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any documents deemed necessary to give effect to the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 8. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
