NOW, THEREFORE, Desorae Giles-Smith, the City Manager of the City of Lauderhill, effective at a.m./p.m. on Tuesday, July 20, 2021, do hereby extend the declaration of a STATE OF EMERGENCY which exists in the City of Lauderhill for the seventy-first seven (7) day extension through July 27, 2027, unless otherwise terminated or extended, as authorized and approved by the City Commission.
