## CITY OF LAUDERHILL DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY (SOE 21-35 Eighty-first COVID 7-Day Extension)

WHEREAS, the Sixty-ninth seven (7) day extension was approved by the City Commission via Resolution No. 21R-07-134 on July 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Seventieth seven (7) day extension was approved by the City Commission via Resolution No .21R-07-143 on July 12, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 21R-07-157 passed on July 14, 2021 by the City Commission which authorized the City Manager to continue to enter into weekly extensions of the Declaration of a State of Emergency for the City of Lauderhill on an as needed basis so long as a State of Emergency continues to exist in the State of Florida regarding COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the changes in legislation relative to Florida Statutes Chapter 252 Emergency Orders by definition do not apply to Declarations of a State of Emergency which are still governed by City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 8½ which are to be declared by the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2021, at 3:00 p.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the seventy-first weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-25) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through July 27, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021, at 2:00 p.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the seventy-second weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-26) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through August 3, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2021, at 4:45 p.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the seventy-third weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-27) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through August 10, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2021, at 10:10 a.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the seventy-fourth weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-28) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through August 17, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2021, at 9:25 a.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the seventy-fifth weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-29) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through August 24, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2021, at 2:00 p.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the seventy-sixth weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-30) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through August 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on August 31, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the seventy-seventh weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-31) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through September 7, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2021, at 9:00 a.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the seventy-eighth weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-32) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through September 14, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2021, at 10:50 a.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the seventy-ninth weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-33) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through September 21, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2021, at 2:00 p.m., the City of Lauderhill declared the eightieth weekly extension of the State of Emergency (SOE 21-34) regarding COVID-19 for the City of Lauderhill effective through September 28, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this SOE 21-35 continues to extend the Declaration of a State of Emergency regarding COVID-19 for the eighty-first seven (7) day extension of the Declaration of a State of Emergency in the City of Lauderhill; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Desorae Giles-Smith, the City Manager of the City of Lauderhill, effective at a.m./p.m. on Tuesday, September 28, 2021, do hereby extend the declaration of a STATE OF EMERGENCY which exists in the City of Lauderhill for the eighty-first seven (7) day extension through October 5, 2021, unless otherwise terminated or extended, as authorized by City Code Chapter 8½.
