

Funding Request Eligibility Requirements

Thank you for expressing interest in receiving funding for the upcoming budget year 2025. Please provide each of the below requirements in order to complete your application. Only complete applications will be considered for funding.

Eligibility Requirements:

Nonprofits must have proof of 501(c) (3) status with Internal Revenue Service (IRS)
A current Certificate of Use (for businesses registered in the City of Lauderhill)
Copy of the most recent audited financial statements
Description of proposed project including detailed budget
Specified amount of funding your organization is requesting from the City
Specified amount of funding your organization will contribute towards the budgeted
expenditures
Specified amount of funding your organization contributed toward program expenditures
during the last budget cycle
Advise the number of Lauderhill residents assisted during the last budget cycle and
provide appropriate proof (ex: registration forms, sign-in sheets, etc.)

Cost per Lauderhill resident served	0-25	
Organization contributions as a percentage of budget	0-20	
Current office location in proximity to Lauderhill (yes-30, no-0)	0-30	

- These financial documents must be accompanied by a statement in writing, signed by a duly authorized representative, stating that the present financial condition is materially the same as that shown on the balance sheet and income statement submitted, or with an explanation for a material change in the financial condition.
