
About Pink Up Lauderhill

The City of Lauderhill is teaming up with Breast Cancer Awareness Advocates like BRCA Strong for the 4th Annual Pink Up Lauderhill featuring two days of breast cancer awareness, education and community events. Kicking off on Friday, October 4, 2024 with the Opening Night Reception and the lighting of the 16 foot tall Pink Breast Cancer Ribbon mounted high up on City Hall. Followed by the Pink Up Lauderhill Community Bike Ride and Health Fair on Sunday, October 6, 2024 featuring breast cancer awareness and education from local health vendors, entertainment, food, and keynote speakers.

Pink Up Lauderhill seeks to raise money in order to help ease the financial worries of Lauderhill breast cancer patients and their families. It is our belief that no one should have to choose between paying essential household bills or paying for medical treatment. Pink Up Lauderhill hopes to help breast cancer patients by providing peace of mind so patients can focus on recovery rather than looming bills. In addition, through awareness and education, we look to share knowledge about breast cancer and it's affects on all ages and sexes; alongside advocating for early detection and mammogram screenings.















2024 FOOD VENDOR RULES

- The Event Organizers are not responsible for cancellation of the event due to inclement weather. No refunds will be given. Spaces are non-transferrable.
- Mandatory setup time for food trucks/booths is 6:00 AM. Health Department Inspections begin at 6:30 am. The event starts promptly at 8:00 am until 1:00 pm.
- Every food vendors must have (1) 2A10BC fire extinguisher with current service tag.
- Only items stated on Event Organizer approved vendor application are permitted to be sold from truck/tent at event. Vendors are responsible for paying their sales tax.
- λ The use of open flame devices or grills must be 10 feet away from food truck or canopy.
- No music or individual entertainment is allowed at Food Trucks or Food Tents.

TENTED FOOD VENDORS

- Non-licensed food vendors are required to pass the on-site inspection by the State of Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation and acquire the State One-Day Permit. According to DBPR website the fee is \$25 and Vendors should call their office to confirm cost. Restaurant owners must provide food handling permit and business license and should be prepared for Dept. of Health food inspection as well.
- Tented food vendors will be provided with a 10 X 10 tent with lights, (1) table and (2) chairs. If a vendor has a branded/logo tent they would like to use the tent must be a commercial grade tent. Tents used at the beach/tailgating/sporting events are prohibited. Tent decorations are provided by the Vendor. Flammable materials and dried vegetation are prohibited as booth decorations. All other materials and supplies needed by the vendor shall be supplied by the vendor.
- 3) TENTED Vendors must provide <u>commercial grade</u>, 12-3 (20 amp rated), indoor/outdoor electric cords <u>that extends a total of 200 feet</u>. Household electric cords are strictly prohibited. Electricity will not be provided if required cords are not provided by vendor. (1) plug per booth is allowed.
- 4) Sharing or sub-leasing of tents is prohibited unless approved in writing by Event Organizers.

FOOD TRUCK VENDORS

- 1) Food Truck Vendors must be **inspected & approved by the Lauderhill Fire Department at least 4 business days prior to event** or they will not be allowed to participate. Please call 954.730.2950 to arrange the Fire Dept. inspection. You must have a scheduled inspection appointment to submit your Food Truck Vendor application.
- 2) The use of portable gasoline generators is strictly prohibited. Household extension cords are strictly prohibited. Only commercial grade indoor/outdoor extension cords are required and must be provided by Vendor.
